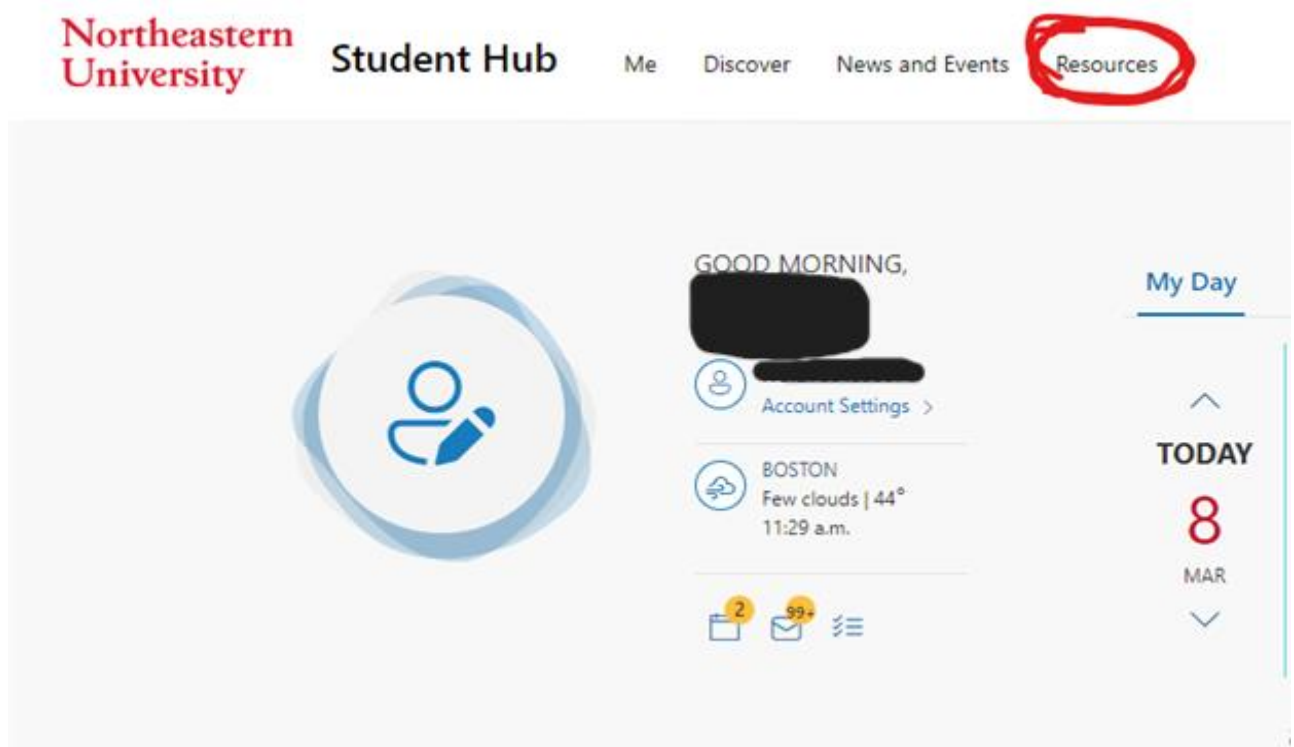


There are two different ways to view your work study award!

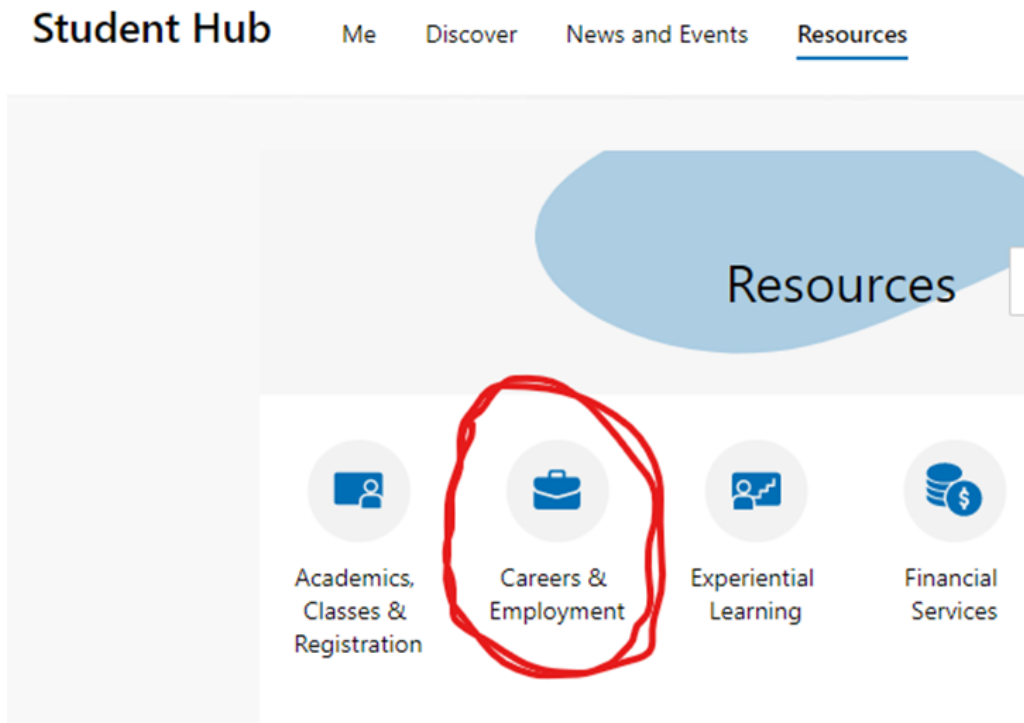
- View Work Study Dashboard on the Student Hub (best for seeing your remaining work study amount once you have started earning)
  - View Through Financial Aid Package (best for checking your work study eligibility, and understanding your award amount per semester)

## How to View Your Remaining Work Study Balance on the Student Hub

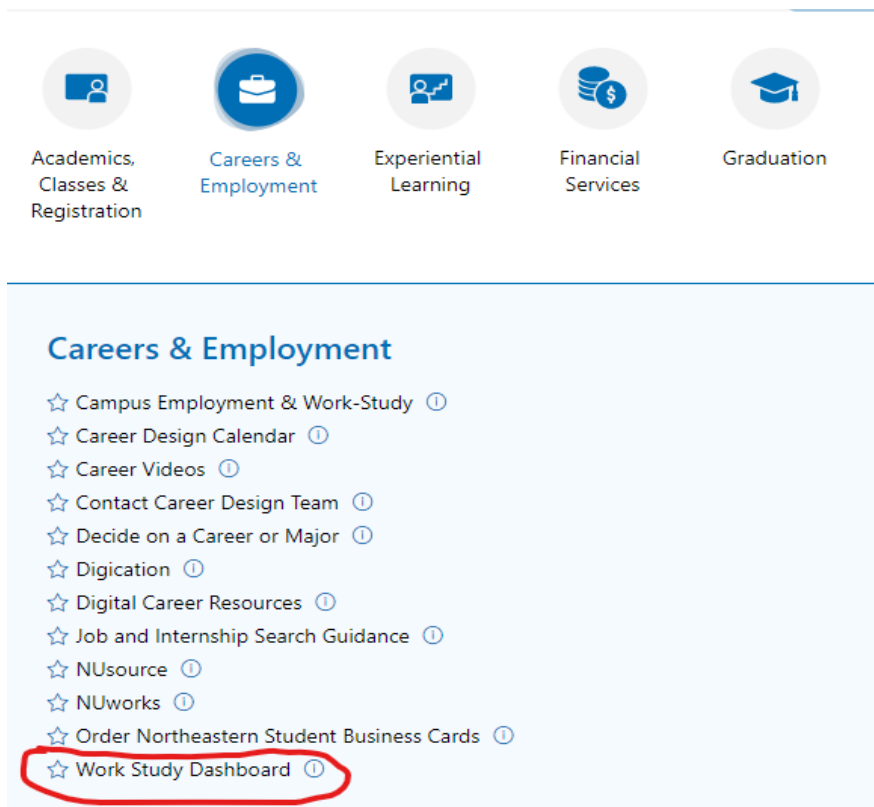
1. Log into <https://me.northeastern.edu>
2. Select the “Resources” tab in the top navigation



3. Select the “Careers and Employment” category



4. Once selected, click “Work Study Dashboard” to see work study award information



5. Click on the “Hide” button to reveal your work study award for the semester and your current semester earnings up until the date listed after “Last Pay Date”.

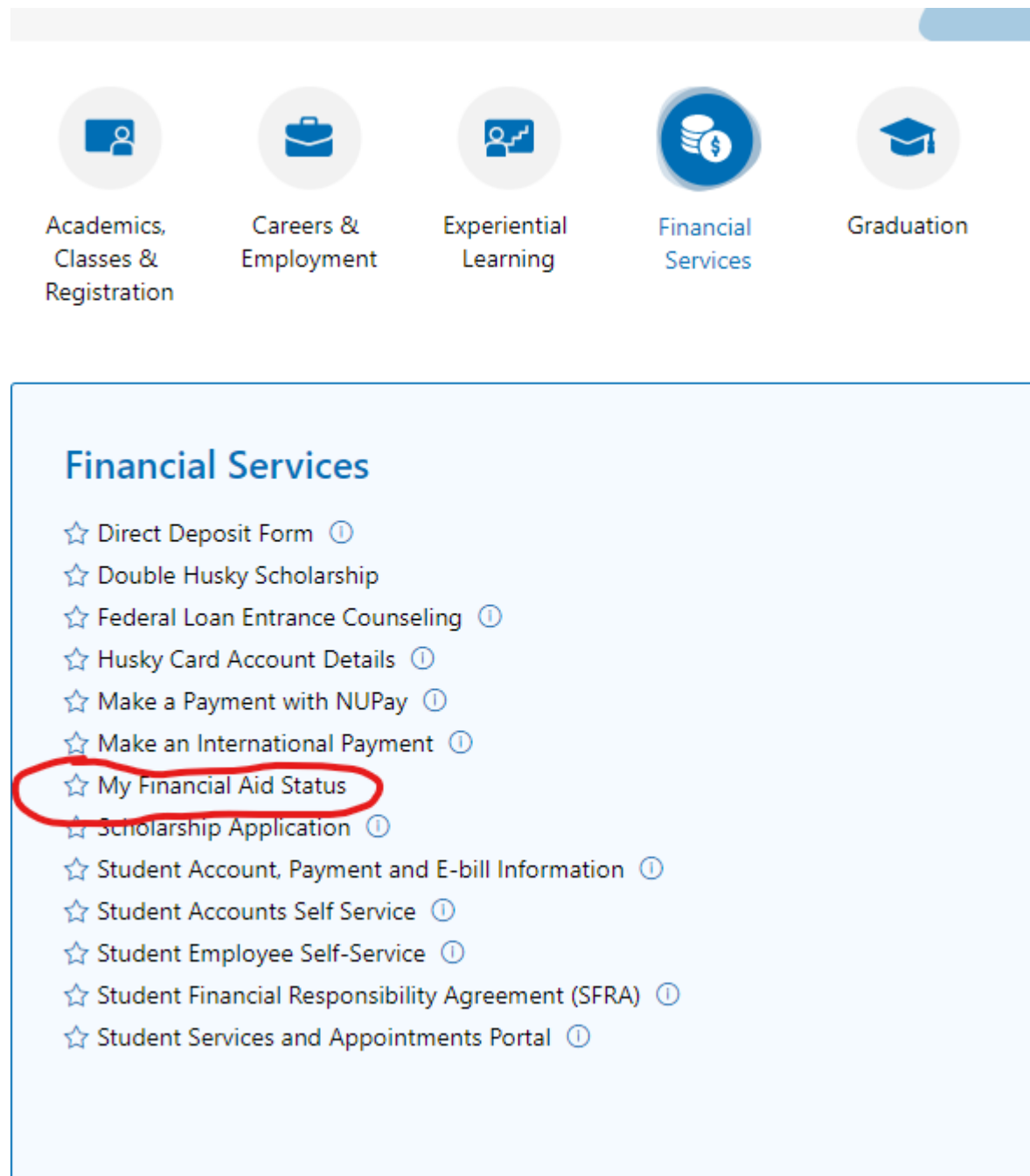

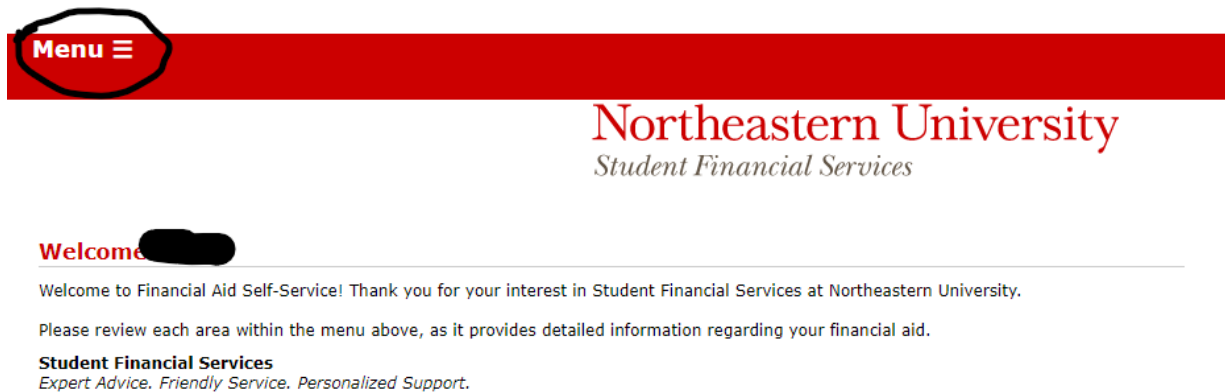

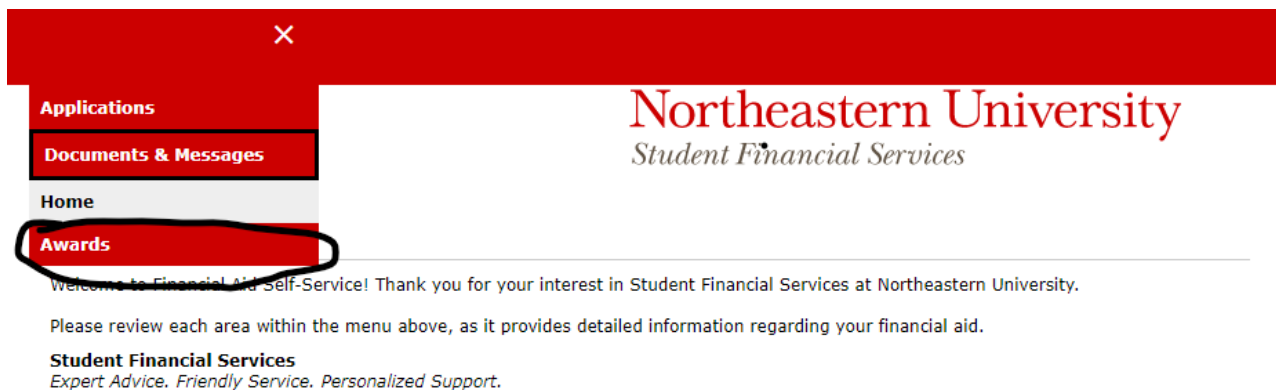
